NVQ Circular No. 07/2024

Termination of National Competency Standards

The Commission, at its meeting No. 2024/04/292 held on 30.04.2024 approved the termination of National Competency Standards of NVQ level 1-4 qualifications listed in Row 1 of the table given below.

The versions of NCS shown in Row 1 of table given below have been revised into a new version shown in Row 2. Accordingly, the NCS given in Row 1 of the table will seize to be effective from 01.05.2024. In place of terminated NCS, the NCS given in Row 2 of the table will be effective for accreditation of CBT courses, student registration for EBT and FLM courses and assessment through RPL modes for awarding of NVQs with effect from 01.05.2024.

Accordingly,

- a. New accreditations in CBT courses will not be approved,
- b. New student enrolment in EBT and FLM courses will not be approved,
- c. RPL assessments will not be approved, in NCS shown in Row 1 of the table after 01.05.2O24.

For the students who currently follow courses in NCS versions shown in Row 1; making assessment requests, conducting assessments and issuing certificates in CBT, EBT and FLM courses can be done until such students receive their certificates. RPL assessments scheduled before 01.05.2024 can be done and results thereof can be uploaded to the NVQ online system and certificates can be obtained.

This circular is valid with effect from 01.05.2024.
